Mesa- With early ballots arriving soon for the November 4<sup>th</sup> election, the Yes on 1 and 2 committee announced the launch of their new website today. You can visit the interactive site at [www.Yeson1and2.com](http://www.Yeson1and2.com).

The site includes an interactive map that allows voters to choose their District and see the projects in their area as well as throughout the City. Also included on the site is an interactive bond calculator, a frequently asked questions section, and sign up section that voters can use to be a part of building a better Mesa.

In light of the economic forecast, the new Mesa City Council cut the bond package by over half to only the most critical of needs. The projects will help reduce emergency response times and help Mesa keep up with growth.
